What’s Your Pleasure

Isaiah 58

Isaiah 58:1- 5

† Do not assume God desires religious activity, God cares about our motivation for pursuing Him

* What religious activities do I pursue for myself?

* What are your religious activities producing?

Jeremiah 2:13

Isaiah 58:6 - 7

† God is not asking for religious rituals, but a selfless, humble pursuit that produces holistic living for God and benefits those around us

Luke 18:14

God’s focus is not a right activity but a right motivation which will produce right activity

* What is the focus of your selflessness? You or others?

Isaiah 58:8 - 11

† The secret in experiencing God’s filling in your life is pouring yourself out

* How are you being selflessly poured out for others as you are being filled through a humble pursuit after God?

To find the fullness you desire you must willing to live selflessly before God.

Isaiah 58:12 - 14

† God desires to bless his people if we would remove the bonds of religion and find freedom in making God our pleasure
