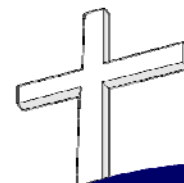

ABCs of Becoming a Christian

Admit that you are a sinner, that your sin separates you from God, and that there is nothing you can do to save yourself.

Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23

Believe that Jesus Christ died on the cross to forgive you of your sins, and that He arose from the dead to give you eternal life.

John 14:6, Romans 5:8

Commit your life to Jesus as the forgiver of your sins and the leader of your life!

Romans 10:9, John 1:12

If you desire to receive Jesus Christ into your life today, we invite you to pray the following prayer. The words in the prayer are not nearly as important as the faith and sincerity in your heart.

"Dear God, thank you for loving me so much that you want me to become your child. I admit that I am a sinner, and that my sin separates me from You, and that there is nothing I can do to save myself. I believe that Jesus Christ died on the cross and arose from death to give me eternal life. I ask You, Jesus, to be the leader of my life. Thank you for saving me today and for making me a part of Your eternal family. Amen."

Joining First Baptist Church

The primary prerequisite for joining our church family is that an individual has accepted Christ as his or her Lord and Savior. "Born again" is another term used to describe the new relationship as indicated in John 3:3-16.

There are several ways to become a member:

1. Come forward at the end of the service during the invitation:
 - By statement—you are a Christian, have been baptized by immersion, and desire to become a member
 - By statement—you are a Christian, but you are requesting membership and baptism by immersion
 - By transfer of letter—you are transferring your membership from a church that also practices baptism by immersion
 - By profession of faith.
2. Meet with a member of the Ministerial staff.
3. Attend a Discovering First class.
