Growth Group Discussion Questions

- 1. What stood out to you from the sermon?
- 2. Read 1 Corinthians 9:16.
 - a. We saw in this verse and today's passage that the apostle Paul is compelled to preach the gospel. Do we view sharing the gospel as more of a responsibility or a privilege?
- 3. How does the gospel being <u>news</u>, instead of <u>advice</u>, give us peace?
- 4. The message of the gospel must never be compromised, but the messenger can show a great deal of flexibility ("becoming all things"). Can you think of any stories of messengers of the gospel (Biblical characters, missionaries you know, etc.) laying down their rights and showing great flexibility?
- 5. If anyone has gone on a mission trip or served with one of our mission partners, share how you saw God at work and how it has impacted you.
- 6. How can we, individually and as a group, better partake in the gospel with our mission partners?
- 7. Spend some time praying for our mission partners.
