Ephesians 1:5-6

- 1. What stood out to you from the sermon?
- 2. Read Romans 8:15 and Galatians 4:4-7. What does it mean for you to be an adopted Child of God?
 - a. How is God choosing us to be holy and blameless separate from the relationship component of being adopted into His family?
 - b. What does it look like for us to approach the Father with the <u>freedom</u> of a son or daughter?
- 3. What privileges do we have as adopted sons and daughters? (Reference 1 John 2:1, Zenhaniah 2:17, Bealm 120:1, 6, Matthew 6:25, 24, Bealm 50:15, Habraus 12:4
 - 3:1, Zephaniah 3:17, Psalm 139:1-6, Matthew 6:25-34, Psalm 50:15, Hebrews 12:4-
 - 11, Matthew 7:11, 1 Corinthians 2:9, Revelation 3:12.)
 - a. How do all of these things encourage us this week?
- 4. Share a time when you greatly felt the love, attention, and passion of a parent or grandparent. Or share a time when one of your kids came to you scared or worried and you showed them the love, attention, and passion of a parent.
 - a. How can we better grasp the magnitude of the love that God has for us as our Heavenly Father?
 - b. Do we tend to view the Father's accessibility and love differently after we sin? Why or why not?
