Belt of Truth

Ephesians 6:14

- 1. What stood out to you from the sermon?
- 2. Do you think we live in a day and time where discerning truth is complicated? Why or why not?
- 3. What are the problems that come from looking for truth in the philosophy of culture or ourselves?
 - a. Where do we tend to look for our source of truth? How can we do a better job to make our ultimate source of truth God's Word?
 - b. How can we engage the culture in their "truths" (without getting pulled into them) and point them back to the hope of the gospel?
- 4. Read Romans 12:1-2. Do we understand that there is a spiritual battle for our minds? Does thinking about this help us better understand the importance of God's Word as truth? Why or why not?
- 5. Pastor Jason explained how to read God's Word to put on the belt of truth. Which of the following statements and questions resonate the most with you? How can we focus on these questions as we are reading God's Word?
 - You should read it to see the magnificence of God. Every time you read, you should ask, what is this revealing about who God is?
 - You should read to hold on to the promises given to you. Whom does God say that you are; what has He promised you?
 - You should read for transformation to be more like Jesus. When was the last time God convicted you and cut you to the core with His Word?
