Helmet of Salvation

Ephesians 6:17

- 1. What stood out to you from the sermon?
- 2. Have you ever wrestled with doubts about your salvation? (Those who feel comfortable share what that looked like in your situation with the group)
- 3. How do you think, act, and feel when you are confident in a situation? How do you think, act, and feel when you are unsure about a situation?
- 4. According to Acts 16:31, what is necessary for salvation?
- 5. According to Romans 10:9-10, what is necessary for salvation?
- 6. Why is it so important to have a clear understanding that our salvation is "Jesus + nothing?"
- 7. Read Romans 8:15-16. Share the evidence(s) you see in your own life ("the Spirit bears witness with our spirit") that you are a child of God (aka saved).
- 8. Putting on the "helmet of salvation" involves reminding yourself of what is true of you because Jesus saves you. Go around your group and share some of those things. (hint: the entire letter of Ephesians is full of statements about what is true of each of us as a Christian)
- 9. Read Hebrews 12:6 and 1 John 5:13-15. How does each of these passages give us assurance and confidence in our salvation?
