Helpful Paradigm: How categories of the OT Law transfer into the New Covenant

Ceremonial Law	Fulfilled in Christ	No longer required
Civil Law	Shift from Nation to Spiritual People	General Principal still applies
Moral Law	Still binding	Strengthened by Christ, begin with the heart

1 Corinthians 9:19-23

19 For though I am free from all men, I have made myself a slave to all, so that I may win more.

20 To the Jews I became as a Jew, so that I might win Jews; to those who are under the Law, as under the Law though not being myself under the Law, so that I might win those who are under the Law;

21 to those who are without law, as without law, though not being without the law of God but under the law of Christ, so that I might win those who are without law.

22 To the weak I became weak, that I might win the weak; I have become all things to all men, so that I may by all means save some.

23 I do all things for the sake of the gospel, so that I may become a fellow partaker of it.
