Children

1. Our parents have lots of different jobs. What job did Ruth have?
2. In the Bible, God tells us to be kind to everyone! How was Boaz kind to Ruth?
3. Even when it's hard, God wants us to show love. How can you show love to your family?

Youth

2. Boaz sought to protect and provide for Ruth. How are you trying to protect and provide for those around you now?
